Basis of the study


Figures extracted from the OBS's LUMIERE Database:

http://lumiere.obs.coe.int

- Over a 10 year period (2003-2012)
- 9 349 European films (with more than 1 000 admissions)
- Produced and released in 36 European countries
- 3.34 trillion admissions

Methodology

- Analysis of the number of films and admissions:
 - By year
 - By territory
 - By gender
 - Market of release (domestic vs foreign)
 - Kind of production (fully national vs international co-production)
- Each film and its admissions have been calculated as a proportion of the gender of its directors.





Number of European films produced in Europe by gender of the director






Evolution of the status quo by gender (I)

Percentage of European films by gender of the director




Evolution of the status quo by gender (II)






What percentage of films by directors of either gender gets a release abroad?

% of European films released in national and foreign markets by gender of the director




How do films by female directors perform abroad?

% of admissions to European films released in national and foreign markets by gender of the director




What are the chances for a woman to shoot an international co-production?









Ranking by number of films





Countries by share of films by female directors









Countries by admissions (in million)





% of films and admissions by gender of the director (2003-2012)




■ Gender not identified ■ Films by female directors ■ Films by male directors

Do films by either gender follow a similar pattern in foreign markets?


European released in national and foreign markets by gender of the director




Ranking by growth in the number of films

Difference between the growth in either gender








Ranking by admissions growth
